CALL THE CLUBHOUSE OFFICE TO FIND OUT YOUR SECTION CAPTAIN

WHAT TO DO IN A DECLARED STATE OF EMERGENCY

- REMAIN CALM!
- BE ALERT!
- LOOK FOR METAL EPIC SIGN AT:
 - LAKE
 - CLUBHOUSE
 - STOP SIGN ON EAGLE PATH
 - SECTION 4 MAILBOXES
- BE PREPARED TO SURVIVE IN YOUR HOUSE FOR MINIMUM OF 3 DAYS. CHECK THE "FIRST 3 DAYS AT HOME" LIST.
- HAVE YOUR PERSONAL FAMILY EMERGENCY PLAN IN EFFECT.
- COMMUNICATE!
- CONTACT YOUR SECTION CAPTAIN IF YOU HAVE AN IMMEDIATE EMERGENCY. IF YOU CANNOT REACH HIM OR HER, CAPTAINS WILL CHECK ON THEIR SECTION RESIDENTS AND GET TO YOU AS SOON AS THEY CAN. SET UP AN EMERGENCY SIGNAL WITH YOUR CAPTAIN IN ADVANCE.
- AFTER 3 DAYS, SOONER IF POSSIBLE, THE CLUBHOUSE COULD OPERATE AS A RED CROSS SHELTER FOR PMLE RESIDENTS AND LOCAL RESIDENTS OR AS A SHELTER FOR PMLE RESIDENTS ONLY.

FIRST 3 DAYS AT HOME

- ✓ 1 gallon water per person, pet p/day
- ✓ Tub and pots full of water
- ✓ Flashlights with extra batteries
- ✓ Transistor or crank radio
- ✓ Fully charged cellphone, laptop, and access to car charger
- ✓ Personalized first aid kit
- ✓ Heavy clothing (pants, socks, hats, gloves, blankets)
- ✓ Whistle or car panic button to signal for help
- Non-perishable foods for 3 days, manual can opener
- ✓ Fire extinguisher
- ✓ Medications
- ✓ Tools to shut off facilities
- ✓ Charcoal for manual BBQ
- ✓ Ample wood supply for fireplace
- ✓ Candles or battery-operated light
- ✓ Matches

EVACUATION PLAN

- ✓ HAVE A BAG PACKED AND LABEL IT!
- ✓ 1 packed bag per person with 7-day supply of clothing, eyeglasses, medical supplies, hearing aids, hygiene items, soap, washcloth, deodorant;
- ✓ Medical equipment LABELED such as oxygen tank, cane, walker, wheelchair, insulin pump with instructions and extra batteries;
- ✓ 7-day supply of all medications -- in original bottles;
- ✓ Emergency contact information;
- ✓ Medical/house insurance papers
- ✓ Personal identification -- pictures of family members including pets;
- ✓ Pet supplies;
- ✓ Baby supplies;
- ✓ Blankets, pillows, sleeping bag;
- ✓ Cash, credit cards.
- ✓ **KEEP YOUR GAS TANK FULL AND CAR BATTERY CHARGED.**
